Tips For Maintaining Sinks

Number one, you have the stainless steel sinks. These are quite easy to maintain and clean. But in order to make sure that you keep it looking brand new, it is still important that you maintain it regularly. One of the most basic way to clean this will be to use dishwashing liquid, water and baking soda. Make sure that you do not use any scouring pads or steel wool pads, as this can definitely cause some scratches on the surface. Just clean it with the mixture and then rinse with water then utilize a soft cloth or paper towel to polish the surface. Adding a drop of vinegar or ammonia is also a good thing to do for a polished look.

Number two, you have porcelain enamel sinks. These are quite precious and expensive thus, you need to maintain them regularly. Make sure that you do not leave acidic stains or food to linger on these kind of sinks. You should know that porcelain sinks are very much prone to acidic stains. What you can do is to get some plastic or perforated mats for protecting these sinks.

Last, you have the stone sinks. These sinks are porous and there are certain substances which can seep in and cause some stains on your sink. It is imperative that you wipe this sink clean always to ensure that deposits do not accumulate such as salt, lime or calcium. Make sure that you use a non-abrasive and neutral detergent when cleaning it to make it look brand new.

So those are some of the common procedures when cleaning these kinds of sinks. Make sure that you know how to clean your sinks to avoid damaging it so that you will have a good looking kitchen for your home.
